Building the right support

At Look Ahead we are committed to meeting the ambitions outlined in the Government's Building the Right Support strategy and action plan.

Working with commissioners and clinicians, we enable people to leave hospitals and secure settings and resettle in the community.

Look Ahead's portfolio of step down services and bespoke packages of support and accommodation include the adaptation of properties which cater for small groups of people or individual care.

Nimrod House in Newham is an example of a service we offer to help meet this agenda.

The cost of a placement at Nimrod House is 24% lower than a typical in patient placement.

This 24-hour service offers accommodation-based care and support for up to five people in selfcontained flats. It provides a unique combination of registered care and supported living services.

Flats are appropriately furnished and use assistive technology to minimise risk while promoting independence. Look Ahead's dedicated staff can offer 1:1 or 2:1 support during waking hours according to need.

We are able to source or purchase properties that can made bespoke to each person to optimise their care.

Our Single Placement Services have been developed in Hertfordshire, Kent and in Newham, East London.

For example our Linden Road service in Hertfordshire was developed by Look Ahead and provides two bungalows.

Staff offer 24-hour waking night support across the properties for two individuals with profound learning disabilities and autism.

Registered care

We provide a number of registered care services for people with learning disabilities and additional needs.

Our Oakview service is a CQCregistered supported living project located in Stevenage, Hertfordshire, for 10 customers with learning disabilities and autism, providing a 24/7 support service.

All of our services are outcomes focused. At Oakview, seven out of 10 customers completed a ten week healthy living course delivered by nurses from Hertfordshire's Learning Disability **Team. Two customers** are in training and volunteering.

Supported living

Look Ahead's supported living services provide anything from 24hour support to a few hours a day. We are experienced in delivering different types of supported living including CQC registered services and core and flexi support contracts. After stepping down from residential care, or high support placements, customers live in our own properties, or in a building owned and managed by others.

Mary Jones Court in Tower Hamlets is a supported living service in Tower Hamlets for adults with low to medium level learning disabilities and autism. Customers may have additional support needs including mental and physical health issues.

It provides self-contained accommodation for 20 customers. some of which is specially adapted. The staff team is available 24 hours a day and customers typically move on after two years.

At Mary Jones Court, 85% customers are in education, training, volunteering or work - 25% customers are in paid employment.

Specialist visiting support

We work with commissioners to deliver visiting support services shaped around the needs of people with learning and physical disabilities, enabling them to live safely within their own homes and maintain their independence.

Community based day support

We also have experience of running day services providing a range of health and wellbeing, leisure and educational opportunities for individuals with varying complexity with or without carers. We work with people with wide ranging needs, attending with or without carers. We can also provide both travel training and transportation support.
